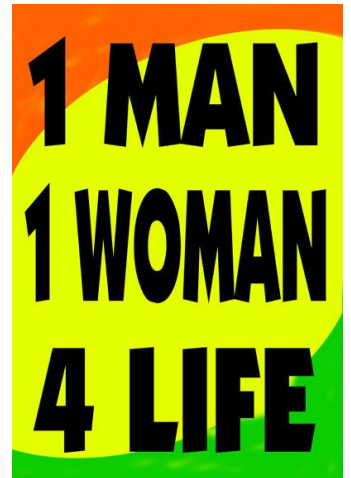

One of the great sins of the country music industry is that they have significantly impacted American culture with the notion that fornication and adultery (including divorce and remarriage) are acceptable, and even honorable. Never mind that God explicitly said not to do it, and Christ warned against it. *“Thou shalt not commit adultery”* (Exodus 20:14). *“Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication”* (Galatians 5:19). *“Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God?”* (James 4:4).



“And he (Christ) saith unto them, Whosoever shall put away his wife, and marry another, committeth adultery against her” (Mark. 10:11). *“Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body”* (1 Corinthians 6:18). *“But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints”* (Ephesians 5:3). *“The LORD hath been witness between thee and the wife of thy youth, against who thou hast deal treacherously: the LORD saith that he hateth putting away: therefore take heed to your spirit, that ye deal not treacherously”* (Malachi 2:14-16).
